The University of Hawai'i - West O'ahu (UHWO) Campus Security Department is firmly committed to providing a safe and secure campus environment.

The Campus Security office is located in the Maintenance/Mechanical Building, room F202.

You can reach Campus Security 24/7 by calling 689-2911 from a mobile phone or 2911 from a campus phone. You can also reach Campus Security by activating one of the Emergency Call Boxes (Code Blue Phones) located throughout campus. (Note: calls to 689-2911/2911 and the Emergency Call Boxes are patched through to a two-way radio system, which enables better, more reliable reception. The two-way radio system only permits one person to speak at a time.)

FIRST AID/CPR/AED EMERGENCIES: Security Officers are trained in emergency First Aid, Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and in the use of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED), which are located throughout campus.

A SAFETY ESCORT SERVICE is provided from dusk to dawn for anyone on campus at night to any University parking lot or facility. Call Campus Security to request a safety escort.

Safety Tips

- Familiarize yourself with the locations of our Emergency Call Boxes (Code Blue Phones).
- **Program the Campus Security emergency number into your cellular phone (689-2911).**
- Sign up for UH Alert Emergency Notifications at <https://www.hawaii.edu/alert/>. UHWO highly recommends that all UHWO students, staff and faculty sign up to UH Alert mobile alerts to get alerts/notifications on events of natural, health or civil emergency at <https://www.hawaii.edu/alert/>.
- Travel/park in lighted areas, travel in pairs if possible, use the escort service.
- Report any suspicious persons or activities, report all incidents no matter how minor, and report losses immediately.
- Be sure to lock/secure doors in your office or room, lock your vans, cars, trucks and bikes, and store valuables in the trunk of your car.
- Do not prop locked doors open.
- Never loan keys to anyone; they may be lost, stolen or duplicated.
- Do not leave your keys in the office.
- Mark or engrave your belongings.
- Do not leave belongings/valuables unattended.
- Keep alert and be aware of your surroundings. Walk confidently and look at people as you are walking.
- Trust your instincts.
- Have keys ready when approaching your car so you will be able to get into your car quickly.
- **Call Campus Security when you:**
 - **Need First Aid/CPR/AED assistance**
 - **See people arguing**
 - **Injured yourself or see someone get injured**
 - **Witness a crime**
