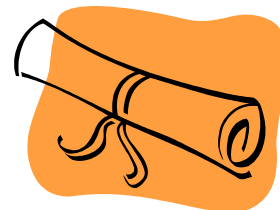

- ANTH 460 Advanced Techniques in Forensic Anthropology (pre: ANTH 297 + L)
- PUBA 309 Criminal Law and Procedures
- SSCI/PUBA490 Practicum

*Note:* Another 12 upper-division credits in anthropology, justice administration, and social sciences are recommended: ANTH 383 Museum Studies, PUBA 410 Issues in Criminal Investigations; SSCI 310 Applied Statistics I or BUSA 320 Statistics for Decision-Making; and SSCI 317 Fieldwork.

Additional requirements (lower-division level)

- ANTH 215+L Physical Anthropology + Lab (4)
- ANTH 297+L Human Skeletal Biology + Lab (4)
- BIOL 101 Biology for Non-Majors (4) **OR** BIOL 171+ L Introduction to Biology + Lab (4)

*Note:* 8 lower-division credits in zoology are highly recommended: ZOOL 240-241 Human Anatomy/Physiology (4-4)

- PSY 406 Assessment and Treatment of Substance Abuse and Addiction
- PSY 407B Practicum in Psychology: Interventions Related to Substance Abuse
- Additional requirements:
  - Expository Writing course
  - Introductory Psychology course
  - Abnormal Psychology course or Culture and Mental Illness course taken within the past 5 years with a grade of "C" or better.

*Note:* The Abnormal Psychology requirement may be satisfied with an upper- or lower-division Abnormal Psychology course.

+ PSY 408 Group Interventions in Substance Abuse and Addiction may be used to substitute for PSY 404.
