

Laulima Student Tutorial: Laulima Fast Facts

What is Laulima?

Laulima is the course management and collaborative resources tool supported for enhanced/total online teaching and collaborative projects at the University of Hawai'i.

Does it affect me?

Yes! Laulima may be your companion throughout your academic career.

- ⇒ Laulima is used to deliver online courses at UHWO.
- ⇒ Hybrid courses and those delivered over Interactive TV (ITV) may also include Laulima as an online component of the course.
- ⇒ In addition, more instructors are choosing to use Laulima tools to enhance in-person courses.

What Can I Do in Laulima?

Your professor may put course content such as handouts, assignments, and tests online. You can also communicate with your professors and classmates using Laulima's e-mail, discussion board, and chat tools.

How Do I Access Laulima?

About a week before the semester begins, students will be able to login to Laulima using their UH username and password at <https://laulima.hawaii.edu>.

Do I Need any Special Computer Equipment or Software?

- ⇒ Be sure your computer meets all the requirements before registering for an online or hybrid course. Please note that a high speed Internet connection is required. Students should also be sure that they have timely access to a computer to complete course assignments, exams, etc., since computer labs may not always be available.
