AFSCME Family Scholarship

Each year AFSCME Family Scholarships Program provides at least 10 \$2000 scholarships to high school seniors that will be renewed each year for a maximum of 4 years as long as the student remains enrolled fulltime. The scholarship may be used for any field of study. To be eligible, the student must be: a graduating high school senior in 2010; be a daughter or son or financially dependent grandchild of an active AFSCME member; and be an applicant to an accredited college or university and subsequently accepted as a full-time student in a four year degree program.

Deadline: December 31, 2009

Award Amount: \$2000
